Minutes from the previous steering committee meeting held on September 11th marked as approved.

WG Status update

- The Working group currently has 58 members, it was also clarified the situation from NIIS, which is a participant member.
- Through the supporting slide it was presented the current status of the WG:
 - Revamp of the FAQ - now a friendly resource but still Work in progress - check it [here](#)
 - White paper on stewards and the CRA progressing and continuation for the work already identified.
 - Attestations work is in the process of being launched, after the project went through community review.
 - Training program work has started, news will be shared soon.
- In terms of relationship with the Institutions
 - CRA Expert Group - Guidance launched by the EC.
 - Letter to the ESOs will be shared soon, it will be open to others to use it as well.
 - Start contacting the national representatives to increase the WG footprint.
- Outreach and Engagement
 - The focus is on Code and compliance
 - We are starting conversations around what to do at FOSDEM
 - There are still events in 2025, after them we will analyse what we can improve in our

communication to engage deeper with the community.

Analysis of the deliverable plan

- After analysing the WG activities trying to extract lessons learned from the process 4 main ideas has been identified:
 - Editor role is key.
 - Team of core contributors is necessary.
 - Those two elements should be clear when an item is proposed.
 - We should not wait for the EC to provide guidance, but focus on what is needed for the community and report those documents as our community view to the European Commission.
- Several ideas were presented to encourage participation:
 - Adding in the deliverable list the name of the editor to give them credit, and encourage others to act as editors gain in visibility
 - Rely on guidance from the European Commission and do not replicate what they are already sharing, keeping in mind the audiences each is addressing.
- In terms of needs, attestations, due diligence and the continuation on the vulnerability reporting area look like the main items to continue working on.

CRA Expert Group

- The agenda for the event has been published and circulated through the WG mailing list. The key aspects for the open source community in it are:
 - ENISA role focusing on two main areas:
 - SBOMs
 - CRA reporting platform - curious about how open source is expected to contribute to it.
 - Guidance package
 - It has been released by the European Commission on the 8th of October, the most relevant ones is the one on FOSS and Risk Assessment.
- A meeting to share information will be organised next week, although it is not possible to share the documents.

Code & compliance event update

- The agenda is almost closed, most of the items are already in the website and now we are pushing

to get more registrations.

- It was proposed to have some interactive exercise to identify interest on different topics, collect inputs for them, and use 15 minutes before closing to share the outcomes and next steps.

AOB

- The refactoring of the ORCWG organization might move some of the traditional paths we followed. Reach out to EF staff if anyone is having issues finding specific information.
- ESOs activities coordination is a very valuable activity and we will arrange a discussion around it at the Code and Compliance meeting.
- There will be a proposal to create the Attestation task force and to host the meetings as part of the WG calendar.
